



Places to Visit


1. Rohtas Fort

Rohtas was an integral part of the Magadha Empire from the sixth to the fifth century. It formed a separate region and joined the Shahbad district in 1972. Tarachandi and the old Rohtasgarh Fort are only two of the area's numerous noteworthy attractions. Rohtas is a well-liked tourist attraction because of its Mughal-era artwork, religious legacy, and historic temples. Like the rest of Bihar, Rohtas comes alive with colourful celebrations of holidays like Dussehra, Diwali, and Chhath Puja, making October through May the ideal time to visit the area. The celebratory décor and the zeal of the locals themselves contribute to the tourist experience.



2. Sher Shah Suri Tomb

The tomb is located in the middle of a huge 22acre pond that is 1,130 feet long (east to west) and 865 feet wide (north to south). To achieve to the main building, visitors must walk through a smaller domed monument north of the pond that was constructed for Sher Shah's concierge. The monument, which rises majestically with turrets on each of its three stories, is a prime example of Pathan architecture's greatest accomplishments. It was much more magnificent than the Taj Mahal, according to British archaeologist Alexander Cunningham.



- **Introduction/Background/Objective**
- **Literature Review**
- **Methodology, Findings, Analysis & Discussion**
- **Conclusion, Limitations and Recommendations**
- **References – Harvard or APA Style is required**
- **Tables, figures, etc. in their appropriate location in the paper (if applicable)**
- **Margins: 1 inch or 2.5 cm.**
- **Font: Times New Roman/ Kruti Dev 011 (12 Size)**
- **Spacing: 1.5 between lines and 2 between paragraphs**
